#### Key features of this series include:

- The use of **short survey essays** - on politics and administration, society and economy, and culture and religion - to outline these major aspects and place them in their broader context;
- **Original historical documents**, each with an introduction and a summation of its content;
- A section detailing important **historical concepts** from each period; this volume explains nationalism, dowries, sectarianism, evangelicalism, economic despression and *laissez-faire* economics;
- Brief **biographies** of major figures are an important feature of each book. This volume includes biographies on: Daniel O'Connell, James Stephens, Paul Cullen, Thomas Davis, and Mary Aikenhead.
