This series is designed to meet the full requirements of the Department of Education’s Leaving Certificate syllabus, but it goes far beyond that, especially in its rich original documentation. This first volume focuses on Catholic Emancipation, the Great Famine of 1846-50, and the radicalization of the Catholic Church that began with the Synod of Thurles (1850). It examines how all three events, in varying ways, changed the face of nineteenth-century Ireland.
