This is the first volume in the new **Four Courts Press History of Ireland Series**, which offers a fresh approach to Irish history since the Act of Union (1801). In place of a general narrative, each book explores key aspects for the period under consideration. Specifically designed to answer to the needs of students, these affordable and accessible books will be an invaluable resource for everyone employed in teaching Irish history.

Ireland, 1815-1870: emancipation, famine and religion focuses on Catholic Emancipation, the Great Famine of 1846-50, and the radicalization of the Catholic Church in Ireland that began with the Synod of Thurles (1850). It examines how all three events, in varying ways, changed the face of 19th-century Ireland. In addition to short survey essays - on politics and administration, society and economy, and culture and religion - that place these events in their broader context, this book contains:

- Original historical documents, each with an introduction and a summation of its content;
- A section detailing important historical concepts from the period, such as nationalism, sectarianism, evangelicalism, dowries, economic despression and laissez-faire economics;
- Brief biographies of major figures of the time, including Daniel O'Connell, James Stephens, Paul Cullen, Thomas Davis, Mary Aikenhead and Charles Edward Trevelyan.
