

Glasnevin Museum

In our events programme this summer we have special tours. On the 19th of June at 3.30pm is the **Literary & Cultural Tour** – from Arthur Griffith to Zozimus visiting the graves of some of the literary and cultural figures in Glasnevin Cemetery. On the 17th of July at 3.30pm we have the **Religions of Glasnevin Tour** - since 1832, Glasnevin Cemetery has been for people of every religion and none, now the final resting place for those from 25 religions. The tour explores some of the traditions and beliefs within the Cemetery.

In addition we have Children's Workshops on the first Saturday of the month at 11.30am.

June 11th 11.30am - **Children's Celtic Design Workshop**. An introduction to the Celtic Knot designs that can be found on the High Crosses at Glasnevin Cemetery. The workshop takes the form of a short tour to see some examples in Glasnevin and then participants have the opportunity to draw a simple Celtic knot themselves. Suitable for children aged 5 – 12yrs.

July 9th 11.30am - **Children's High Cross Workshop**. Early High Crosses were decorated with pictures to teach biblical stories to communities. Children will be brought on a tour into the Cemetery to see some of the fine examples of story pictures on the Celtic High Crosses before coming back to the Museum to draw their own. Suitable for children age 8-12yrs. Both workshops are free of charge and last 1 hour.

So why not visit us for these or some of our other tours and events. If your party is 10 or more we can offer one of our special interest tours, in addition to the **Religions of Glasnevin** and **Literary & Cultural Tours** we have a **Joycean Tour**, **Women of Glasnevin** and **Military History Tours**. We also have tours for young people following the school curriculum in history, current levels are **Leaving Certificate**, **Junior Certificate** and **5th & 6th Class tours**.
